Tackling the Climate Crisis: Report on the Webinar "Global Warming, Human Conduct, and Climate Ethics"

In its ongoing commitment to fostering critical dialogue on pressing societal issues, the PG Department of Sociology at Noble Women's College, Manjeri, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized a thought-provoking webinar titled "Global Warming, Human Conduct, and Climate Ethics" on March 26, 2022. This timely event brought together academic experts, students, and concerned citizens to explore the complex interplay between human actions, environmental consequences, and ethical considerations in the face of the global warming crisis.

The program commenced with a warm welcome address by Dr. Abdussalam M.P., Head of the Department of Sociology. This was followed by an inspiring inauguration by the esteemed Principal, Dr. (I.Ledr) C.K. Abdul Rabbi Nisar. Setting the stage for the central discussion, renowned research scholar Mr. Namuelheen from Malayalam University delivered the keynote address. Drawing upon his extensive research and expertise, Mr. Namuelheen delved into the intricate links between human conduct, particularly unsustainable practices, and their escalating impact on the planet's climate. He emphasized the urgent need for a shift in our ethical framework, advocating for environmental consciousness and responsible choices in every aspect of our lives.

Enhancing the discourse further, second-year Sociology student Fathima Rumman delivered a heartfelt welcome speech, expressing the department's dedication to raising awareness about climate change and its ethical implications. 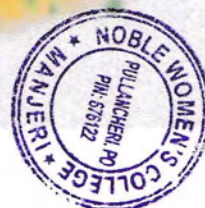

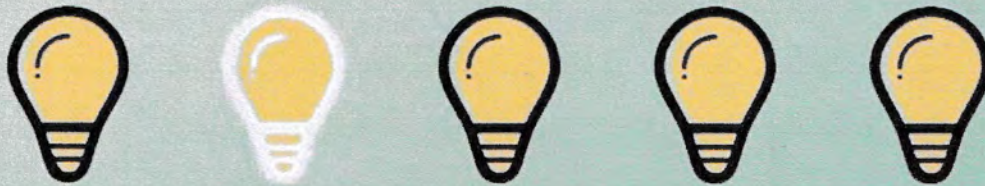
